KINGSGATE'S SAFE CHILD SCHEME

Kingsgate Management, in conjunction with Fife Constabulary have launched their Safe Child scheme for the protection of children who become separated from their parents while shopping in the town.

These simple actions by shop staff will make all the difference in effecting a swift re-uniting of parent and child.

If a child approaches you, keep them at the till point in full view of all within the store. If possible keep two members of staff near to the child at all times. Ask the child for their name and a family telephone contact number. Inform your supervisor or security immediately. Where you have use of a Shopsafe or equivalent radio system, transmit brief details/description IMMEDIATELY. Do NOT transmit names! Where you do not have access to a Shopsafe or equivalent radio system, please contact **Kingsgate Centre Security Control on 01383** 735254 without delay. Kingsgate will coordinate. Make a PA announcement within the store/centre. If no carer is found within 5 minutes, contact the Police on Shopsafe or on 0845 600 5702 as this is now deemed a major incident.
